

<u>Challenged Athletes Foundation</u>: What began as three friends' kindness and compassion to help one athlete paralyzed in triathlon has now grown into a powerful current that has carried and supported those with physical challenges – empowering them to find community, confidence, and conviction.

Grant Name: Annual Grant

- *Grantee Disabilities Served:* Individuals worldwide with permanent physical disabilities.
 - Hearing impairments, Intellectual and developmental disabilities do not qualify for support through CAF.
- Grant Details (amount financed/what can be applied for):
 - Sports Expense Grant
 - o Equipment Grant
- Grant Deadlines: Open Sept 2023- November 2023

Grant Name: Operation Rebound Grants

- *Grantee Disabilities Served:* members of the U.S. armed forces, active military personnel, as well as U.S. law enforcement officers, firefighters and paramedics with permanent physical injuries.
- Grant Details (amount financed/what can be applied for):
 - Sports Expense Grant- training, competitions, or equipment purchases and maintenance max request \$1,500.
 - Equipment Grant- equipment of choosing from a preferred vendor of CAF- max \$2,500.
- Grant Deadlines: Year round

Grant Name: Ossur Grants

- Grantee Disabilities Served: athletic prostheses must have lower extremity amputations or limb differences.
- *Grant Details (amount financed/what can be applied for):* Individuals may only apply for eligible Össur products.
- Grant Deadlines: Year round

Grant Name: Idaho Grant

- *Grantee Disabilities Served:* Residents of Idaho with permanent physical disabilities. Hearing impairments, Intellectual and developmental disabilities do not qualify.
- Grant Details (amount financed/what can be applied for):
 - o Sports Expense Grant
 - Equipment Grant
 - Funding Towards Equipment
- Grant Deadlines: Year round

<u>Kelly Brush Foundation</u>: The Kelly Brush Foundation (KBF) is dedicated to making active lifestyles a reality for those who have experienced a spinal cord injury. We offer the inspiration to believe and the grants to enable anyone to buy the equipment they need to get out and go.

Grant Name: The Active Fund

- *Grantee Disabilities Served:* Individuals with paralysis caused by spinal cord injury.
- *Grant Details (amount financed/what can be applied for)*: any piece of sports or recreation equipment designed for people with disabilities that allows for the applicant to be active.
 - Usually around 3500 not exceeding 5000.
 - Try it first- grant awards of \$500 towards program or rental fees at an adaptive program to gain experience with equipment applied for.
- *Grant Deadlines:* Spring Cycle- Feb 1- April 12, Fall Cycle July- September.

Grant Name: Path2Active

- *Grantee Disabilities Served:* Individuals with paralysis caused by spinal cord injury who reside in the US.
- Grant Details (amount financed/what can be applied for): The KBF's new Path2Active Scholarships provide financial support to individuals who want to try a new sport, test out a piece of equipment, or build skills by attending camps, clinics or other adaptive sports programs.
 - Up to \$500
- *Grant Deadlines:* July 15, 2022 July 31, 2023

<u>High Fives:</u> High Fives focuses on preventing life-changing injuries and provides resources and hope if they happen.

Grant Name: Cycle 1

- *Grantee Disabilities Served:* Those injured in outdoor adventure sports and wounded veterans pursuing outdoor adventure sports.
 - These include spinal cord injuries, traumatic brain injuries, amputation or other mobility-limiting injuries that occurred in an individual's lifetime
- Grant Details (amount financed/what can be applied for):
 - Grant funding, paid to service providers in specific funding categories: adaptive sports equipment, healing network, medical equipment, programs, living expenses, and emergency care/injury expenses.
- Grant Deadlines: 1/1-1/31, 5/1-5/31 or 8/1-8/31

<u>GoHawkeye Enabling Grant Program</u>: To provide support to adaptive organizations and individuals through financial aid, outdoor experiences and film making meant to inspire people of all abilities. Our films showcase people overcoming disabilities and reaching their goals through active lifestyles and outdoor adventures.

Grant Name: Sports Equipment Grant

- *Grantee Disabilities Served:* This grant program is open to adaptive individuals and organizations in the United States and consists of adaptive sports equipment and adaptive sports experience grants.
- *Grant Details (amount financed/what can be applied for):* Awards are based on funds available at the time of the awards cycle.
- Grant Deadlines: May 1, 2023

Grant Name: Sports Experience Grant

- *Grantee Disabilities Served:* This grant program is open to adaptive individuals and organizations in the United States and consists of adaptive sports equipment and adaptive sports experience grants.
- *Grant Details (amount financed/what can be applied for):* Awards are based on funds available at the time of the awards cycle.
- Grant Deadlines: May 1, 2023

<u>Victoria's Victory Foundation</u>: Victoria's Victory Foundation is an organization founded on the desire to help other's rise above challenges and achieve their own personal victories.

Grant Name: Victory Program

- Grantee Disabilities Served: People living with mobility challenged related disabilities in the US.
- *Grant Details (amount financed/what can be applied for):* \$3,000-\$6,000.
 - o Uses
 - Activity Based Training
 - Mobility Equipment (Mono skis, adaptive bikes, other adaptive Equipment)
 - Caregiver Hours
 - Home and Vehicle modifications
- Grant Deadlines: Open between 3/1/23-4/28/23

Grant Name: Athletes Helping Athletes


- *Grantee Disabilities Served:* Grant recipients must be 18 years of age or younger and have a permanent physical disability (severe mobility impairment i.e., paraplegia, quadriplegia, amputation etc.).
- *Grant Details (amount financed/what can be applied for):* Adaptive Bike that the grant recipient must be able to **self-propel the bike without assistance.**
- Grant Deadlines:

<u>Catapult</u>: Catapult strives to help all individuals, from those who just experienced a life-changing event, to those wanting to a find a hobby and improve their quality of life, to athletes who are Team USA Paralympic athletes and hopefuls.

Grant Name: Annual grant

- *Grantee Disabilities Served:* To visually impaired and mobility impaired athletes.
- Grant Details (amount financed/what can be applied for):
 - Competition Fees
 - o Transportation and Lodging Costs
 - Adaptive Sports Equipment Purchase
 - Coaching and Training Fees, and More
- Grant Deadlines: Applications open spring of 2023

Grant Name: Imagination Grants: Advancing Opportunity and Inclusion for People with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities Grants

- *Grantee Disabilities Served:* Organizations must have a primary focus of serving people with intellectual or developmental disabilities. Programs eligible for funding include education, advocacy, employment, the arts and supportive, inclusive, or independent housing.
- *Grant Details (amount financed/what can be applied for):* \$15,000 to \$25,000. Max is \$50,000.
- *Grant Deadlines:* Opens January February.

Grant Name: Imagination Planning Grants for IDD Housing

- *Grantee Disabilities Served:* Organizations must have a primary focus of serving people with intellectual or developmental disabilities. Programs eligible for funding include education, advocacy, employment, the arts and supportive, inclusive, or independent housing.
- *Grant Details (amount financed/what can be applied for):* Max is \$50,000. Depending on overall project budget.
- *Grant Deadlines:* Opens January- February.

<u>MEC Disabilities</u>: Our Charity's Mission is to help motivate, elevate, and celebrate disabilities by helping educate the public, get adaptive equipment for children with disabilities, and getting ADA playground equipment for schools across the United States. Every child deserves an equal opportunity to learn, grow, and play no matter their abilities..

Grant Name: Adaptive Equipment/Tools Grant

- *Grantee Disabilities Served:* Adaptive Medical & Nonmedical Equipment for anyone 21 years of age or younger residing in the United States.
- Grant Details (amount financed/what can be applied for): Not listed.
- Grant Deadlines: Ongoing.
